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To seek contractual services to update the 25-year old wastewater master plan through the City's procurement policies and procedures in order to properly provide for adequate, efficient and effective wastewater management services to all users, including State/Federal/local government properties, residential/commercial properties.

Citizens are served with improved regional wastewater management services by having an updated wastewater master plan that serves as a tool for City decision makers in addressing critical wastewater services for all existing and future users that includes Polk County Central Regional Service Area, Town of Eagle Lake, and the City of Bartow.

The target population is the City of Bartow which serves as the City seat for Polk County and for Regional, Federal and State offices, agencies, properties and buildings, which are tax exempt creating a reduction of revenue that is needed to adequately serve its citizenry and surrounding communities.
