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The project is focused on improving water quality and sanitation in the FGUA Lehigh Acres service area by transitioning septic tank sewer systems to a more modern and reliable treatment system. This is beneficial not only for residents but also for the surrounding environment, particularly the Caloosahatchee Basin and Estuaries, which are impacted by excessive nutrient loading.

The main activities include public outreach, permitting, project management, grant management, construction and inspection services.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The main activities include public outreach, permitting, project management, grant management, construction and inspection services.

Lehigh Acres community will benefit in the project area identified removing septic tanks for approximately 1000 citizens.
