However, as R491 is an arterial roadway and an evacuation route; the roadway is regionally connected to counties beyond our litical subdivision limits. CR491 is a primary commercial and truck/freight corridor for the County. CR491 continues to a top ranked transportation improvement project and is on the LOPP list for the Hernando/Citrus MPO.
