a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Funding requested will go towards updating and renovating nine (9) auditoriums in high schools throughout the school district, including upgrades to lighting, audiovisual systems, equipment, curtains, wiring, and other related infrastructure improvements. These improvements will enhance Visual and Performing Arts programs throughout Miami-Dade County Public Schools, specifically in under-served areas where VPA programming options are under-enrolled, limited or unavailable.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The upgrades and improvements to the auditoriums in nine (9) high schools throughout the district will enhance Visual and Performing Arts programs in Miami-Dade, specifically in under-served areas where program options are limited or unavailable. Renovations to lighting, audiovisual systems, equipment, curtains, wiring, and other necessary improvements are crucial to high-quality VPA programs.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Students will have increased opportunities and equitable access to high-quality Visual and Performing Arts programs in newly renovated venues with updated systems and equipment for performances and exhibitions. Students will be able to apply to a broader range of colleges/scholarships, gain educational/cultural enrichment, and prepare for careers in the visual and performing arts industry.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Over 800 high school students throughout Miami-Dade County Public Schools are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of this project is to increase opportunities for students, ensuring equitable access to Visual and Performing Arts programs in areas where options are limited or unavailable. Students will also have the opportunity to apply to a broader range of colleges/scholarships and prepare for careers in the Visual and Performing Arts industry. This will be measured by the tracking and recording of performances, presentations, and exhibitions held at the auditoriums.
