4. Project/Program Description

The City of Palm Bay (City) is requesting state appropriations or grant support to provide monetary assistance in continued expansion of the City's fiber infrastructure. The fiber infrastructure expansion would separate the City's utility and non-utility network infrastructure and establish a continuous underground fiber optic cabling solution to remote City facilities. Upon completion, most City facilities will connect to a redundant network fiber ring, eliminating outages due to a single point of failure and reducing recurring local internet service provider communication fees, resulting in a more resilient network. This is Phase 4 of a project previously funded under the Florida Digital Service aimed to enhance cybersecurity and harden critical infrastructure.

Continued enhancement of the City's cybersecurity network, providing a redundant underground network fiber ring, eliminating outages due to a single point of failure, resulting in a more resilient network and hardened cybersecurity infrastructure.

The City will utilize existing contracts to continue expansion of the fiber network.

As a municipal services provider, the enhanced cybersecurity will better secure private information stored on the City's network as well as isolate the utilities system to avoid cybersecurity incidents through the City's utilities infrastructure.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The general public of Palm Bay, FL. Palm Bay has a rapidly growing population of approximately 140,000 residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit and outcome of this project is enhanced cybersecurity to protect the City's operational network and utilities infrastructure, which will safeguard the City and the residents of Palm Bay. This expansion will also provide hardened infrastructure in the event of emergencies, man-made or natural, which will protect the organization and citizen data and reduce the time off-line due to an emergency event or bad actor.

It is reasonable to expect the contracting agency forfeit funds for failure to perform or reimburse the state for funds that are not expended in accordance with this request. For outside contractors, the City of Palm Bay's Procurement Department provides language related to 'Notice of Deficiencies' identifying who/what is at fault, a deficiency or error, and provides the contractor time to cure it. The City uses default language related to non-performance by the contractor.
