Construction of a new public safety station to serve the Flaghole and Montura communities which are located in a rural, outlying area in Hendry County. The relocation of the current Montura station will better serve the entire area for response times, including the US27 Corridor. Currently, there is no public safety stations that would encompass all of public safety in the unincorporated area on the eastern side of the county outside of the City limits.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

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Increased Fire, EMS, and Sheriff's deputy coverage while allowing emergency personnel to stage in their stations during a major storm event, which is not possible at this time due to current facility not rated for storm events.

Construction of the station will provide faster emergency response times to residents and visitors on blue sky days as well as during a major storm event.

Hendry County has a population of approximately 40,000 residents.

Faster emergency response times. This will be measured by showing when a call is placed to 9-1-1 and the time it take for responders to get to the scene of the incident.
