4. Project/Program Description

To provide an adequate potable water supply and meet fire flow protection requirements within the distribution territory, water infrastructure improvements are necessary. The City of Clewiston desires to replace 2800 linear feet of a70 year old asbestos cement transmission water main with an appropriately sized PVC pipe material. The estimated cost for the needed improvements is approximately \$1,200,000.

13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To materially improve the municipal water facility; ensure adequate fire flow protection; enhance property values by providing for additional flows and allow for environmental upgrades by decommissioning asbestos material in the existing water distribution system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

For a resilient water utility infrastructure to be achieved while meeting service demands by providing for adequate water flow, the City of Clewiston's water transmission line must be upgraded as proposed by this project.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The requested funds are necessary to materially improve the water distribution system and ensure a reliable, safe water supply with adequate fire flow protection and extend the useful life of the facility. Importantly, the requested funding will provide for the much needed improvements in a manner that will allow customer rates to remain affordable in a fiscally constrained community with among the highest unemployment rates and lowest wage rates in the state.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The completion of the water main improvements will benefit the entire population within the City limits and areas served outside the City currently including the Harlem community totaling approximately 9700 residents and 424 commercial businesses.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project will positively impact public health, safety and welfare by improving the capabilities for the provision of an adequate water supply and more adequately meet fire flow safety requirements for the affected area. The City can measure decrease in frequency and quantity of breaks and system pressure loss which impacts operating costs and contributes to lowering the amount of groundwater resources needed from wells that supply the City's Reverse Osmosis water treatment plant.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

As these are public investments in infrastructure and provided that the City uses the funds appropriately under state agency oversight, no penalties should be incurred by the responsible local government agency.
