Holmes County has struggled for several years with an inmate population at or near capacity. Therefore, additional infrastructure is needed to assist with meeting these demands. In addition to needing more space for inmates, the Sheriff intends to expand the drug treatment and rehabilitation services he offers for inmates re-entering the community.

Design and construction of the infrastructure needed for 64 beds of 2 man cells and a frame of half of 256 inmates. This would also allow for an infill of another 64 beds by adding cells along with major infrastructure tie ins.
