Funds will be used to purchase property along Carpenter Creek for stream and floodplain restoration projects that have been identified in the Carpenter Creek/Bayou Texar Watershed Management Plan. Over \$6,000,000 in grant funds have already been allocated for stream and floodplain restoration project construction. This project will reduce downstream flooding, improve water quality in impaired waters, improve riparian and aquatic habitat, and increase recreational opportunities for citizens and tourists.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Purchase property along Carpenter Creek so that \$6,000,000 in allocated grant funds can be used to construct projects to reduce downstream flooding, improve water quality in impaired waters, improve riparian and aquatic habitat, and increase recreational opportunities for citizens and tourists.

**b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?**

State of Florida and Escambia County purchasing protocols will be followed for the property acquisition. Two appraisals will be performed on the parcels to be purchased.

**c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?**

After property acquisition, \$6,000,000 in allocated grant funds will be used to construct projects to reduce downstream flooding, improve water quality in impaired waters, improve riparian and aquatic habitat, and increase recreational opportunities for citizens and tourists.

**d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?**

Target populations who will be served by this project include citizens of Escambia County and tourists who enjoy utilizing the natural resources and recreational opportunities of fishing, swimming, and kayaking along Carpenter Creek and Bayou Texar. 50,000 individuals per year are expected to be served and enjoy the natural resources and recreational benefits of this project.

**e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?**

Outcomes of this project include reduction in downstream flooding, improvement of water quality in impaired waters, improvement of riparian and aquatic habitat, and increased recreational opportunities for citizens and tourists. Outcomes will be measured by quantifying reduced downstream flooding events, improvements in water quality (fecal coliform bacteria and nutrients), and increased usage by citizens and tourists.
