13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Little Wekiva River, located on the west side of Seminole County, is designated an Outstanding Florida Water and part of the Wekiva Aquatic Preserve. This request supports the construction of an upstream sedimentation basin adjacent to the Little Wekiva River. A sedimentation basin is a settling pond that collects and traps sediment-laden runoff before it enters a waterway, preventing further sedimentation and damage to the River and its ecosystem.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The Little Wekiva River is used by canoes and kayaks and members of the public in general. Fish, otters, turtles, and alligators inhabit the River. Project activities will provide restoration and proactive maintenance of the River by preventing catching runoff from rain storms and other events, allowing the sediment to settle to the bottom of the basin rather than entering the waterway.
