	Our funding request will be used to produce five new episodes of "The Voice Inside", a TV series based on true stor resilience within the autism community and beyond. This will allow us to create an eight-episode mini-series to pitch national and international platforms like PBS, Angel Studios, and Hulu. Our writers, including one on the spectrum, houtlined additional episodes to ensure long-term expansion.							
	Additionally, funding will support ten screening events in 2025-2026 across South and Central Florida, including Miami-Dade County, Broward County, Palm Beach County, and Orange County. These events will feature screenings, live performances, and motivational speeches by autistic self-advocates, fostering inclusion and community engagement.

13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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We will produce five more episodes of "The Voice Inside" series, and ten screening events featuring "The Voice Inside", along with musical performances and speeches by inspiring autistic self-advocates. Based on true stories of resilience, the series inspires all audiences. Funds will create paid jobs for young adults with and without disabilities working at the highest level of professionalism as actors, musicians, motivational speakers, event production team members, and administrators.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

We will produce five new episodes of "The Voice Inside" and host ten screening events, featuring the series, musical performances, and speeches by autistic self-advocates. Events will include stories of resilience shared by our motivational speakers, talkbacks, and live musical performances. These events will educate all audiences, particularly students and the autism community, highlighting self-determination and faith in people of all abilities. Funds will create paid jobs, especially for disabled young adults.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

We will provide jobs in particular to young adults with disabilities, educate school-aged children at our events using "The Voice Inside" series, and provide inspiration and motivation for autism families, by showcasing the work and true success stories of our actors, speakers, writers, and musicians on the spectrum.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

We will especially serve persons with poor mental health, persons with poor physical health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, and at-risk youth. Through continued broadcasting on South Florida PBS, and potentially nationwide, a minimum of 6 million viewers are expected to be reached. Through our in-person events, up to 4,255 people will be additionally served. A minimum of 15 screen actors, writers, live performers, motivational speakers, and musicians with disabilities, already committed to the Autism Theater Project, will receive paid jobs in 2025/2026, and more jobs are expected to be created on an ongoing basis.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Autism Theater Project empowers actors, writers, musicians, and speakers on the spectrum by providing a platform to share their stories, build self-esteem, and work alongside colleagues of all abilities. The Voice Inside increases autism awareness, teaches practical mental health tools, and fosters emotional resilience in Generation Z. The series and speaking engagements promote empathy, friendship, and inclusion, helping to prevent bullying. Additionally, the project creates jobs for individuals with disabilities and supports community organizations through select fundraising events.

We will record the number of jobs created, compensation provided, number of jobs we anticipate to create, and satisfaction of our workers through surveys and carefully kept records. We will also keep track of how the Autism Theater Project's events helped increase fundraising and visibility for our community partners. Participant surveys and post-event testimonial videos will also be used.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

If deliverables or performance measures are not met, the Autism Theater Project will submit a corrective action plan with a revised timeline. Payments may be withheld for specific unmet milestones, with flexibility to resolve issues. Continued non-compliance could affect future funding eligibility. The Autism Theater Project will maintain communication with APD to adjust the project as needed, ensuring progress and preserving partnerships.
