a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Through the Circle of Love's signature initiative, the Youth of Valor Empowerment Program (YOVE) provides high school completion support, college preparation workshops, career readiness experiences a very popular, program and attracts youths from more than one public schools annually. Due to the collaboration of the college that is collaborating to working with the organization for the S.T.E.M, the organization launches another great tagline @ College Bound. Career Focus. The different initiatives are designed to bolster high school graduation and college acceptance rates among the contemporary multicultural girls, ages 13-18, who are enrolled in grades 9-12 in public.

The Circle of Love DBA Youth of valor Empowerment (YOVE) exists as a haven for nurturement, self-improvement, and confidence building for impressionable young ladies in need of a supplemental support system, or an extension of their familial, school and church communities. The majority of our enrollees have been deemed "at-risks" of falling victim to societal pressures such as teenage pregnancy, self-esteem issues, drug abuse, homelessness, sex trafficking, and the juvenile justice system. The program is committed to defying stereotypes, negatives connotations and preconceived notions that have historically associated # of Attend - 45 or more yearly.

The Circle of LOVE DBA I AM Y.O.V.E. Program for several years has continued to come out with 100% high school graduation rate; with that, one of the college that collaborates with the program has been offering 100% scholarship to the Y.O.V.E.
