a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

With the relocation of American Magic Sailing team to the Pensacola area our City will be hosting numerous regattas and sailing events throughout the year. With this increase in boating and aquatic activity the City will need more access to respond to potential water related accidents. As an ISO 1 rated fire department adding this capability will make us a more resilient city. We would also be able to respond to incidents that needs additional response on the FDOT 3 mile bridge.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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This water asset emergency response vessel is equipped to combat fires on waterfront structures and ships, at the Port of Pensacola, delivering large volumes of water for firefighting, providing search and rescue operations, aiding in the evacuation of people in distress, and offering emergency medical support, all while navigating through hazardous environments like rough seas or polluted waters.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Pensacola fireboat will enhance public safety by providing rapid water-based emergency response, including firefighting, search and rescue, and medical assistance. Positioned strategically along the coastline, it will ensure quicker access to the Port of Pensacola, protect valuable maritime assets, and support disaster response efforts, benefiting citizens with improved safety and quicker response.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All citizen of the City of Pensacola, Escambia County and Santa Rosa County that will be in Pensacola Bay.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduction in response time-The city records response times. There should be a decrease in response times for fire boat related incidents.

Reduction in property lost-The total number of property loss will decrease.

Increased boater safety-The number of boat related accident will decrease.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Penalties include written notification to correct within 30 days. If still not corrected the agency shall submit termination of agreement in writing to include effective termination date. If terminated the state could utilize the boat in the same area for their needs in the area.
