Subsection (15) is added to section 601.10, 15 16 Florida Statutes, to read: 601.10 Powers of the Department of Citrus.--The 17 Department of Citrus shall have and shall exercise such 18 19 general and specific powers as are delegated to it by this 20 chapter and other statutes of the state, which powers shall 21 include, but shall not be confined to, the following: 22 (15) To provide by rule a list of forms used in 23 conducting its business. 24 Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 601.61, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 25 601.61 Bond requirements of citrus fruit dealers.--26 27 (2) Said bond shall be in the form approved by the 28 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and shall be 29 conditioned as provided in s. 601.66(9), and also to fully 30 comply with the terms and conditions of all contracts, verbal

with other citrus fruit dealers, relative to the purchasing, handling, sale, and accounting of purchases and sales of citrus fruit, and upon the dealer accounting for the proceeds from, and paying for, any citrus fruit purchased or contracted for, in accordance with the terms of the contracts with producers, and upon the dealer accounting for any advance payments or deposits made, and delivering all citrus fruit contracted for, in accordance with the terms of the contracts with other citrus fruit dealers. The commission may prescribe by rule that such a producer contract contain information that it considers necessary to protect the producer from deceptive practices. For purposes of this chapter, every such contract shall be conclusively deemed to have been made and entered into during the shipping season in which the delivery of fruit into the primary channel of trade is made.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

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SENATE SUMMARY

Requires the Department of Citrus to provide, by rule, a list of the forms that it uses in conducting its business. Allows the Florida Citrus Commission to prescribe by rule that a producer contract must contain information that the commission considers necessary for the protection of the producer from deceptive practices.

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
