28	<u>or household member against that child unless those acts are</u>		
29	<u>found by the court to constitute "harm" or "child abuse or</u>		
30	<u>neglect" as defined in s. 415.503. This paragraph does not</u>		
31	<u>apply to cases where the injunction for protection is granted</u>
