For this purpose, 16 17 the authority is authorized and empowered: (18) To participate in and issue bonds and other forms 18 19 of indebtedness for the purpose of establishing and 20 maintaining an accounts receivable program on behalf of a 21 health facility or group of health facilities. 22 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this part, the structuring and financing of an accounts receivable program 23 pursuant to this subsection shall constitute a project and may 24 25 be structured for the benefit of health facilities within or outside the geographical limits of the local agency. An 26 27 accounts receivable program may include the financing of 28 accounts receivable acquired by a health facility from other health facilities, whether or not controlled by or affiliated 29 30 with such health facility and whether or not located in this 31 state.
