Short title. -- This act shall be known as 18 the "Chief Richard B. and Nina Wardlow Highway Safety Act." 19 20 Section 2. Section 316.0891, Florida Statutes, is 21 created to read: 22 316.0891 Speed limit; use of certain lanes prohibited 23 for certain vehicles as determined by department. --24 (1) Speed limits for trucks with three or more axles 25 and noncommercial buses posted on interstate highways, the 26 Florida Turnpike, and other limited access highways, as 27 determined by the department, shall be 10 miles per hour less 28 than the posted speed limit for other vehicles. 29 (2) Trucks with three or more axles and noncommercial 30 buses are prohibited from using the left lane, or left two

lanes, if so determined by the department, on interstate

highways, the Florida Turnpike, and other limited access highways that have three or more lanes of travel in the same direction.

Section 3. Subsection (2) of section 316.0895, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.0895 Following too closely.--

(2) It is unlawful for the driver of any motor truck, motor truck drawing another vehicle, or vehicle towing another vehicle or trailer, when traveling upon a roadway outside of a business or residence district, to follow within 300 feet of another <a href="mailto:vehicle">vehicle</a>, motor truck, motor truck drawing another vehicle, or vehicle towing another vehicle or trailer. The provisions of this subsection shall not be construed to prevent overtaking and passing nor shall the same apply upon any lane specially designated for use by motor trucks or other slow-moving vehicles.

Section 4. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall post the appropriate highway signs as required by this act within 180 days from the effective date of this act.

Section 5. This act shall take effect October 1, 1997.

HOUSE SUMMARY Provides that speed limits for trucks with three or more axles and noncommercial buses posted on interstate highways, the Florida Turnpike, and other limited access highways, as determined by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, shall be 10 miles per hour less than the posted speed limit for other vehicles. Provides that trucks with three or more axles and noncommercial buses are prohibited from using the left lane, or left two lanes, if so determined by the department, on interstate highways, the Florida Turnpike, and other limited access highways that have three or more lanes of travel in the same direction. Directs the department to erect appropriate signs within 180 days from October 1, 1997.
