Present subsections (15), (16), (17), (18), 24 (19), (20), (21), (22), (23), (24), (25), (26), (27), (28), 25 and (29) of section 581.011, Florida Statutes, are renumbered 26 as subsections (16), (17), (18), (19), (20), (21), (22), (23), 27 (24), (25), (26), (27), (28), (29), and (30), respectively, 28 and a new subsection (15) is added to that section, to read: 581.011 Definitions. -- As used in this chapter: 29 30 (15) "Landscape designer" means a person who engages, for compensation, in consultation concerning or the planning,

design, or construction of exterior spaces, using plant materials and incidental paving and building materials. 2 3 Section 2. Subsection (11) of section 581.031, Florida Statutes, is amended and subsections (31) and (32) are added 4 5 to that section to read: 6 581.031 Department; powers and duties.--The department 7 has the following powers and duties: 8 (11) To suspend or revoke certificates of inspection and of registration of nurserymen, stock dealers, agents, and 9 10 plant brokers, and landscape designers in the state. 11 (31) To make and issue certificates of registration to landscape designers, authorizing them to operate within the 12 13 state. 14 (32) To adopt rules relating to certificates of 15 registration for landscape designers. Section 3. Section 581.035, Florida Statutes, is 16 17 amended to read: 581.035 Preemption of regulatory authority over 18 19 nurseries. -- It is the intent of the Legislature to eliminate 20 duplication of regulatory authority over nurseries and landscape designers. Notwithstanding any other law to the 21 contrary, the authority to regulate, inspect, and permit: 22 23 (1) Nursery owners, plant brokers, and stock dealers; 24 and 25 (2) Nurseries, nursery stock, plants, and plant products, including any aquatic plant as defined in s. 369.22 26 27 which is grown in a nursery; and, 28 Landscape designers 29 30 is preempted to the department.

581.131 Certificate of registration.-
(9)(a) If the registration has not been renewed or the
fee has not been paid by the renewal date, a penalty of \$10 or
20 percent of the renewal fee, whichever is greater, shall be

- (b) If the registration has not been renewed or the fee has not been paid within 31 days of the renewal date, the department shall stop sale or stop movement on all nursery stock until the person has renewed the certificate of registration.
- (c) If the registration has not been renewed or the fee has not been paid within 31 days after the renewal date, the landscape designer may not provide landscape design services until he or she has renewed the certificate of registration.
- $\underline{(d)(c)}$ Upon application prior to the renewal date, the department may, for good cause supported by written documentation, extend the renewal date without penalty for up to 90 days.
- (11)(a) Before any landscape designer may provide any service defined in s. 581.011(15) in this state, he or she must apply to the division, on forms supplied by the division, for a certificate of registration.
- (b) The department shall provide qualifications for registration by rule, according to the following minimum criteria:

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1	1. Completion of a bachelor's degree in ornamental
2	horticulture, landscape design and management, or a related
3	field from an accredited university;
4	2. Completion of an associate of science or arts
5	degree in landscape design, horticulture, landscape
6	management, or a related field from an accredited community
7	college and 2 years of full-time documented experience in
8	landscape design;
9	3. Completion of a 1-year certificate in ornamental
10	horticulture, landscape management, or a related field from an
11	accredited technical center and 4 years of documented
12	full-time experience in landscape design;
13	4. Completion of 6 years of full-time practical
14	experience in landscape design; or
15	5. Certification in landscape design issued by a
16	not-for-profit organization whose criteria are recognized by
17	the department as being at least as stringent as the criteria

19	(12) This section does not apply to architects

(1) REVOCATION AND SUSPENSION. -- If it is determined by

revocation and suspension; fines.--

plant broker is selling or offering for sale, or is distributing or offering to distribute, nursery stock or that a landscape designer is providing landscape design services in violation of the provisions of this chapter and the rules adopted under this chapter, or has aided or abetted in such violation, the department may revoke or suspend her or his certificate of registration or the use of any certificates, permits, or agreements issued by the division. Further, the department may refuse or suspend the certification of any nursery stock or plant product when it is determined that plant pests exist on the stock or product or that the nursery or site is in such condition with regard to growth and cultivation that an efficient inspection for plant pests cannot be made.

(2) FINES; PROBATION. --

- (a)1. The department may, after notice and hearing, impose a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or probation not exceeding 12 months, or both, for the violation of any of the provisions of this chapter or the rules adopted under this chapter upon any person, nurseryman, stock dealer, agent, or plant broker, or landscape designer. The fine, when paid, shall be deposited in the Plant Industry Trust Fund.
- 2. The imposition of a fine or probation pursuant to this subsection may be in addition to or in lieu of the suspension or revocation of a certificate of registration or certificate of inspection.
- (b) Whenever any administrative order has been made and entered by the department imposing a fine upon any person pursuant to this subsection, the order shall specify the amount of the fine and the time limit for payment, which shall not exceed 15 days. Upon failure to pay the fine within such

time, the certificate of registration or certificate of inspection of the person may be suspended or revoked without further hearing; and a fine of \$100 per day may be imposed for each day the violation continues. Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998. SENATE SUMMARY Provides for the regulation of landscape designers by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Establishes requirements and guidelines for the issuance of certificates of registration and provides grounds for discipline. Provides penalties.
