Section 3. Section 110.1092, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

110.1092 Telephone voice mail systems and telephone menu options systems.--

(1) No state employee shall utilize a voice mail system when the employee is at his or her regularly assigned work station where his or her telephone is functional and available for use, unless such voice mail system alerts the caller to, and provides the caller with access to a nonelectronic attendant, or automatically transfers the caller to a nonelectronic attendant.

(2) Telephone menu options systems used by state agencies, departments, or other state government units, will alert the caller to, and provide the caller with access to a nonelectronic attendant.
