1 House Memorial 2 A memorial requesting the United States 3 Congress to prepare and submit to the states an 4 amendment to the United States Constitution 5 prohibiting federal courts from ordering a 6 state to levy or increase taxes. 7 8 WHEREAS, separation of powers is fundamental to the 9 United States Constitution, and the power of the Federal Government is strictly limited, and 10 WHEREAS, under the United States Constitution, the 11 12 states are to determine public policy, and 13 WHEREAS, it is the duty of the judiciary to interpret the law, not to create law, and 14 15 WHEREAS, our present Federal Government has strayed from the intent of our founding fathers and the United States 16 17 Constitution through inappropriate federal mandates, and 18 WHEREAS, these mandates, by way of statute, rule, or 19 judicial decision, have forced state governments to serve as 20 the mere administrative arm of the Federal Government, and 21 WHEREAS, federal district courts, with the acquiescence 22 of the United States Supreme Court, continue to order states to levy or increase taxes to comply with federal mandates, and 23 WHEREAS, these court actions violate the United States 24 Constitution and the legislative process, and 25 26 WHEREAS, the time has come for the people of this great 27 Nation and their duly elected representatives in state 28 government to reaffirm, in no uncertain terms, that the 29 authority to tax under the Constitution of the United States 30 is retained by the people who, by their consent alone, do delegate such power to tax explicitly to those duly elected

representatives in the legislative branch of government whom they choose, such representatives being directly responsible and accountable to those who have elected them, and

WHEREAS, several states have petitioned the United States Congress to propose an amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, the amendment seeks to prevent federal courts from levying or increasing taxes without representation of the people and against the people's wishes, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the Congress of the United States prepare and submit to the several states an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to add a new article providing as follows:

Neither the Supreme Court nor any inferior court of the United States shall have the power to instruct or order a state or a political subdivision thereof, or an official of such a state or political subdivision, to levy or increase taxes.

That this application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United States.

That the Legislature of the State of Florida also proposes that the legislatures of each of the several states comprising the United States that have not yet made a similar request apply to the United States Congress requesting

enactment of an appropriate amendment to the United States Constitution, and apply to the United States Congress to propose such an amendment to the United States Constitution.

That the Secretary of State of the State of Florida transmit copies of this memorial to the President and Vice President of the United States, the presiding officer in each house of the legislature in each of the states in the Union, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the President of the United States Senate, and to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.
