A bill to be entitled

An act relating to vehicular homicide; amending s. 782.071, F.S.; redefining the offense of "vehicular homicide" to include the killing of an unborn quick child by any injury to the mother which would be vehicular homicide if it resulted in the death of the mother; providing penalties; reenacting ss. 921.0012(3)(h) and 960.03(3), F.S., relating to the offense severity ranking chart and the definition of "crime" with respect to the Florida Crimes Compensation Act, respectively, to incorporate said amendment in references; amending s. 921.0012, F.S., relating to the offense severity ranking chart, to conform terminology; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 782.071, Florida Statutes, 1996 Supplement, is amended to read:

782.071 Vehicular homicide.--"Vehicular homicide" is the killing of a human being, or the killing of an unborn quick child by any injury to the mother of such child which would be vehicular homicide if it resulted in the death of such mother, by the operation of a motor vehicle by another in a reckless manner likely to cause the death of, or great bodily harm to, another. Vehicular homicide is:

(1) A felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
