Beginning July 1, 1998, through June 30, 27 2001, the state tax on sales, use, and other transactions 28 imposed by chapter 212, Florida Statutes, on the sale of an 29 automobile or truck for personal use at the rate of 6 percent 30 shall be reduced to a rate of 4 percent. This section does not apply to the purchase of an automobile or truck for commercial 31 1

use in a business or trade. This section does not affect the rate of any discretionary sales surtax levied under the authority of chapter 212, Florida Statutes. Prior to July 1, 2001, the Legislature shall review this rate reduction, considering the economic outlook for the state, and determine whether this rate reduction should be extended. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Provides that the state sales tax on the sale of an automobile or truck for personal use shall be reduced from 6 percent to 4 percent for 3 years, beginning July 1, 1998. Provides for review of this reduction by the Legislature before the reduction expires.
