| 13 | 259.035, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: |
| 14 | 259.035 Advisory council; powers and duties |
| 15 | (2)(a) The council shall, by the time of the first |
| 16 | board meeting in February of each year and at additional times |
| 17 | during the year as deemed necessary by the council, establish |
| 18 | or update a list of acquisition projects selected for purchase |
| 19 | pursuant to this chapter. In scoring potential projects for |
| 20 | inclusion on the acquisition list, the council shall give |
| 21 | greater consideration to projects that can serve as corridors |
| 22 | between lands already in public ownership or under management |
| 23 | for conservation and recreational purposes. Acquisition |
| 24 | projects shall be ranked, in order of priority, individually |
| 25 | as a single group or individually within up to 10 separate |
| 26 | groups. The council shall submit to the board of trustees, |

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1 which the project cannot be properly managed, an 2 identification of those projects or parcels within projects 3 which should be acquired in fee simple or in other than fee 4 simple, an explanation of the reasons why the council selected 5 a particular acquisition technique, a management policy б statement for the project, a management prospectus pursuant to 7 s. 259.032(9)(b), an estimate of land value based on county 8 tax assessed values, a map delineating project boundaries, a 9 brief description of the important natural and cultural 10 resources to be protected, preacquisition planning and 11 budgeting, coordination with other public and nonprofit public-lands acquisition programs, a preliminary statement of 12 the extent and nature of public use, an interim management 13 14 budget, and designation of a management agency or agencies. 15 The Department of Environmental Protection shall prepare the information required by this section for each acquisition 16 17 project selected for purchase pursuant to this chapter. In addition, the department shall prepare, by July 1 of each 18 19 year, an acquisition work plan for each project on the 20 acquisition list for which funds will be available for acquisition during the fiscal year. The work plan need not 21 disclose any information that is required by this chapter or 22 23 chapter 253 to remain confidential. 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 25 law. 26 27 28 SENATE SUMMARY 29 Authorizes the Land Acquisition and Management Advisory Council to establish multiple lists of projects each 30 year. 31

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
