Pursuant to Section 5 of Article XI of the 15 State Constitution, there shall be a special election on 16 17 September 1, 1998, at which there shall be submitted to the electors of Florida for approval or rejection Senate Joint 18 19 Resolution No. 528 proposing an amendment to Section 11 of Article VII of the State Constitution, to authorize the 20 issuance of state bonds to finance or refinance the 21 22 acquisition of lands and improvements for conservation, outdoor recreation, and water resource development projects. 23 Section 2. Publication of notice shall be in 24 accordance with Section 5 of Article XI of the State 25 Constitution. The special election shall be held as other 26 27 special elections are held. 28 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, if passed by a vote of at least three-fourths of the 29 30 membership of each house of the Legislature. 31 1
