A bill to be entitled

An act relating to personnel of the district school system; amending s. 230.23, F.S.; requiring district school boards to grant credit for specified instructional experience in determining salary schedules; amending s. 231.36, F.S.; requiring notification to instructional staff on annual contract of nomination status; providing a requirement when not renominated; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section 230.23, Florida Statutes, 1996 Supplement, is amended to read: 230.23 Powers and duties of school board.--The school board, acting as a board, shall exercise all powers and perform all duties listed below:

- (5) PERSONNEL.--Designate positions to be filled, prescribe qualifications for those positions, and provide for the appointment, compensation, promotion, suspension, and dismissal of employees as follows, subject to the requirements of chapter 231:
- (c) Compensation and salary schedules.—Adopt a salary schedule or salary schedules to be used as a basis for paying all school employees, such schedules to be arranged, insofar as practicable, so as to furnish incentive for improvement in training and for continued and efficient service and fix and authorize the compensation of school employees on the basis of such schedules. A district school board, in determining the salary schedule for instructional personnel, shall consider

the prior teaching experience of a person who has been 1 designated state teacher of the year by any state in the 2 3 United States and shall grant credit to any newly hired member of the instructional staff for all previous instructional or 4 teaching experience in another Florida school district. 5 6 Section 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 7 231.36, Florida Statutes, 1996 Supplement, is redesignated as 8 paragraph (c), and a new paragraph (b) is added to said 9 subsection to read: 231.36 Contracts with instructional staff, 10 11 supervisors, and principals .--12 (1)13 (b) The school board of each district shall notify, in writing, each instructional staff member holding an annual 14 15 contract of his or her nomination status for the subsequent 16 school year. Written reasons shall be provided to 17 instructional staff who are not renominated by the school 18 board. Section 3.
