**Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 87, between lines 14 & 15 of the bill

insert:

Section 82. On or before December 31, 1998, the Department of Elderly Affairs shall design, establish and implement a self-funded, long-term care plan to be included in the state group insurance program for active, retired, and deceased state, local, and, to the extent allowable under federal law, federal officers and employees, and their respective spouses, children, stepchildren, parents, and parents-in-law. The Department of Elderly Affairs shall determine whether the plan shall be funded on a pre-tax or post-tax contribution basis. Consistent with the selection criteria established in paragraphs (3)(e) and (5)(c) of s. 110.123 for the division, the Department of Elderly Affairs shall contract with a professional administrator to implement and market the plan.
