The Committee on Community Affairs recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 4, line 3, through  
page 5, line 3, delete those lines

and insert:

(14) The holder of a tax certificate may not directly, through an agent, or otherwise initiate contact with the owner of property upon which he or she holds a tax certificate to encourage or demand payment.

(15) Any holder of a tax certificate who initiates, or whose agent initiates, contact with the property owner upon which he or she holds a certificate encouraging or demanding payment may be barred by the tax collector from bidding at a tax certificate sale. Unfair or deceptive contact by the holder of a tax certificate to a property owner to obtain payment is an unfair and deceptive trade practice, as referenced in s. 501.204(1), regardless of whether the holder of the tax certificate redeems the tax certificate. 1 unfair or deceptive contact is actionable under ss.  
 2 501.2075-501.211. If the holder of the tax certificate later  
 3 redeems the certificate in reliance on the deceptive or unfair  
 4 practice, the unfair or deceptive contact is actionable under  
 5 applicable laws prohibiting fraud.
