33-900-98 A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to education; creating the "Florida Maximum Class Size Goals Act"; 3 4 providing intent; providing goals relating to 5 class size in certain grade levels; providing 6 for funding; providing for review of statutory 7 mandates; requiring annual reports and a study based on class size reductions; providing an 8 9 effective date. 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 11 12 Section 1. (1) This section may be cited as the 13 "Florida Maximum Class Size Goals Act." 14 (2) The Legislature finds that class size, especially 15 in the primary grades, is a major factor in the ability of 16 17 students to learn and of classroom teachers to teach. It is, therefore, the intent of the Legislature to establish class 18 19 size standards that will promote educational success. 20 (3) It shall be the goal of the Legislature and each 21 school district that each elementary school in the school 22 district beginning with kindergarten in the 1998-1999 school year, for kindergarten and grade level one in the 1999-2000 23 school year, for kindergarten and grade levels one and two in 24 25 the 2000-2001 school year, and for kindergarten and grade levels one, two, and three in the 2001-2002 school year, class 26 27 sizes not exceed 20 students, with a ratio of one 28 full-time-equivalent teacher per 20 students. For the purposes of this act, class sizes that exceed 20 students meet 29 30 the goal if, for every ten students above a base of 20 students, there is at least one full-time-equivalent teacher 31 1

1 aide in the classroom for the same number of hours as the 2 students. 3 (4) Each school district shall implement the goals in this section to the extent funds are provided through the 4 5 General Appropriations Act. б (5) Beginning January 1, 1999, and each year 7 thereafter, the Department of Education shall report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 8 Representatives school district expenditures and class size 9 10 reductions as a result of this act. 11 (6) The Department of Education shall provide for a longitudinal study of the benefits to students and the impact 12 13 on student achievement of small class size based on reductions in class size for the 1998-1999 school year, as a result of an 14 appropriation for such purpose, and for the 1999-2000, 15 2000-2001, and 2001-2002 school years, as a result of 16 17 implementation of this act. The results of the study shall be reported to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the 18 19 House of Representatives by December 1, 2002. 20 Section 2.
