790.15 Discharging firearm in public.--

(1) Except as provided in subsection (2) or subsection 20 (3), any person who knowingly discharges a firearm in any public place, or on or over the right-of-way of any paved public road, highway, or street, or whosoever knowingly discharges any firearm over the right-of-way of any paved public road, highway, or street or over any occupied premises commits is guilty of a felony misdemeanor of the third first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, or s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. This section does not apply to a person lawfully defending life or property or performing official duties requiring the discharge of a firearm or to a person discharging a firearm on public roads or properties expressly
