Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 13 121.055, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 14 121.055 Senior Management Service Class. -- There is 15 hereby established a separate class of membership within the 16 17 Florida Retirement System to be known as the "Senior Management Service Class, " which shall become effective 18 19 February 1, 1987. 20 (1)(c)1.a. Effective January 1, 1990, participation in 21 22 the Senior Management Service Class shall be compulsory for up 23 to 75 nonelective positions at the level of committee staff director or higher or equivalent managerial or policymaking 24 25 positions within the House of Representatives, as selected by 26 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, up to 50 27 nonelective positions at the level of committee staff director 28 or higher or equivalent managerial or policymaking positions 29 within the Senate, as selected by the President of the Senate, 30 all staff directors of Joint Committees of the Legislature, the Auditor General and up to 9 managerial or policymaking

positions within his or her office as selected by the Auditor General, and the executive director of the Commission on Ethics.

- b. Effective January 1, 1999, participation in the
  Senior Management Service Class shall be compulsory for up to
  175 nonelective positions within the Senate which are selected
  by the President of the Senate and for which participation is
  not compulsory pursuant to sub-subparagraph a. and up to 275
  nonelective positions within the House of Representatives
  which are selected by the Speaker of the House of
  Representatives and for which participation is not compulsory
  pursuant to sub-subparagraph a.
- 2. Participation in this class shall be compulsory, except as provided in subparagraph 3., for any legislative employee who holds a position designated for coverage in the Senior Management Service Class, and such participation shall continue until the employee terminates employment in a covered position.
- 3. In lieu of participation in the Senior Management Service Class, in the discretion of the Joint Legislative Management Committee, such members may participate in the Senior Management Service Optional Annuity Program as established in subsection (6).

Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1999.

## SENATE SUMMARY

Authorizes the President of the Senate to designate additional employees of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to designate additional employees of the House of Representatives, for whom membership in the Senior Management Service Class of the Florida Retirement System will become compulsory.
