Medical history records, bank account numbers, credit card numbers, telephone numbers, and information 18 19 related to health or property insurance furnished by an 20 individual to any agency pursuant to federal, state, or local 21 housing assistance programs are exempt from the provisions of 22 subsection (1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. 23 Any other information produced or received by any private or public entity in direct connection with federal, state, or 24 25 local housing assistance programs, unless the subject of another federal or state exemption, is subject to subsection 26 27 (1).28 2. Governmental agencies or their agents are entitled 29 to access to the records specified in this paragraph for the 30 purposes of auditing federal, state, or local housing programs or housing assistance programs.

3. This paragraph is repealed effective October 2, 2002, and must be reviewed by the Legislature before that date in accordance with s. 119.15, the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995. Section 2. The Legislature finds it is a public necessity that medical history records, bank account numbers, credit card numbers, telephone numbers, and information related to health or property insurance furnished to a housing assistance program be held confidential and exempt from public records requirements because revealing such information could create the opportunity for fraud and is an unnecessary intrusion into the personal affairs of the program participants. Section 3.
