Such permits shall specifically 18 prohibit solicitation upon any public street, highway, or road 19 by children 15 years of age or younger. Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 337.406, Florida 20 Statutes, is amended to read: 21 22 337.406 Unlawful use of state transportation facility 23 right-of-way; penalties.--(1) Except when leased as provided in s. 337.25(5) or 24 25 otherwise authorized by the rules of the department, it is 26 unlawful to make any use of the right-of-way of any state 27 transportation facility, including appendages thereto, outside 28 of an incorporated municipality in any manner that interferes with the safe and efficient movement of people and property 29

from place to place on the transportation facility. Failure

to prohibit the use of right-of-way in this manner will

endanger the health, safety, and general welfare of the public by causing distractions to motorists, unsafe pedestrian movement within travel lanes, sudden stoppage or slowdown of 3 traffic, rapid lane changing and other dangerous traffic 4 movement, increased vehicular accidents, and motorist injuries 5 6 and fatalities. Such prohibited uses include, but are not 7 limited to, the free distribution or sale, or display or solicitation for free distribution or sale, of any 8 merchandise, goods, property or services; the solicitation for charitable purposes; the servicing or repairing of any 10 vehicle, except the rendering of emergency service; the 11 storage of vehicles being serviced or repaired on abutting 12 13 property or elsewhere; and the display of advertising of any 14 sort, except that any portion of a state transportation 15 facility may be used for an art festival, parade, fair, or other special event if permitted by the appropriate local 16 17 governmental entity. Within incorporated municipalities, the local governmental entity may issue permits of limited 18 19 duration for the temporary use of the right-of-way of a state transportation facility for any of these prohibited uses if it 20 21 is determined that the use will not interfere with the safe and efficient movement of traffic and the use will cause no 22 23 danger to the public. Such permits shall specifically prohibit the use of right-of-way of a state transportation 24 25 facility, including appendages thereto, for solicitation by 26 persons 15 years of age or younger. Before a road on the 27 State Highway System may be temporarily closed for a special 28 event, the local governmental entity which permits the special 29 event to take place must determine that the temporary closure 30 of the road is necessary and must obtain the prior written approval for the temporary road closure from the department.

Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to authorize such activities on the Interstate Highway System. Local governmental entities may, within their respective jurisdictions, initiate enforcement action by the appropriate code enforcement authority or law enforcement authority for a violation of this section. Section 3.
