 - (6) For the purposes of this legislation:
- (a) "Alternative fuels" and "cleaner burning fuels" includes electricity, biodiesel, natural gas, propane, reformulated fuel and any other cleaner burning fuel that is designated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency.
- (b) "Alternative fuel vehicles" also referred to as
 "AFV's" include on-and-off-road transportation vehicles,
 light-duty, medium-duty, or heavy-duty which are powered by an
 alternative fuel or a combination of alternative fuels or as
 revised in the future by DCA in partnership with the Task
 Force.
