The Department of 22 Education in collaboration with the departments and colleges 23 of education shall develop procedures for continued program 24 approval that document the continuous improvement of program 25 processes and graduates' performance. 26 (d) Beginning with the 1998-1999 academic year, 27 continued approval for a teacher preparation program is 28 contingent upon the institution's providing all students with 29 the option of a 1-year internship in a school located in a socially and economically disadvantaged urban or rural area. 30 31 Each college of education in the State University System must 1

offer students the option of earning credit during a 1-year internship designed to provide the intern with the necessary supervision and teaching methodology to become an effective teacher of students who live in a disadvantaged area. The internship must be for 12 student credit hours and must be incorporated within the approved hours required for a bachelor's degree. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1997. SENATE SUMMARY Provides that, beginning with the 1998-1999 academic year, continued approval for a teacher preparation program is contingent upon a postsecondary educational institution's providing students with the option of a 1-year internship, carrying 12 hours of credit toward a bachelor's degree, which is designed to help them effectively teach disadvantaged students. 2.6
