(3) District school boards may develop cooperative 24 25 agreements with community agencies or organizations for the use of community resources, including park and recreation 26 27 department facilities. 28 (4) The Commissioner of Education shall adopt rules and standards for the implementation of the provisions of this 29 30 section.
