An act relating to confidential information;
amending s. 945.10, F.S.; deleting a provision
that presentence or postsentence investigative
records are confidential; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section
945.10, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

945.10 Confidential information.--

(1) Except as otherwise provided by law or in this
section, the following records and information of the
Department of Corrections are confidential and exempt from the
provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State
Constitution:

(b) Preplea or, pretrial intervention, ~~presentence or
postsentence investigative~~ records.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Deletes a provision that makes presentence and
postsentence investigative records confidential and
exempt from the open records law.
