Subsection (1) of section 232.0315, Florida 10 Statutes, is amended to read: 11 232.0315 School-entry health examinations.--(1) The school board of each district and the 12 governing authority of each nonpublic school shall require 13 that each child who is entitled to admittance to 14 prekindergarten or kindergarten, or is entitled to any other 15 16 initial entrance into a public or nonpublic school in this 17 state, present a certification of a school-entry health examination and a certification of a school-entry vision 18 19 examination and analysis performed within 1 year prior to 20 enrollment in school. The school board of each district, and 21 the governing authority of each nonpublic school, may 22 establish a policy which permits a student up to 30 school days to present a certification of the examinations a23 school-entry health examination. Any school board which 24 establishes such a policy shall include provisions in its 25 local school health services plan to assist students in 26 27 obtaining the health examinations. However, any child shall 28 be exempt from the examinations requirement of a health 29 examination upon written request of the parent or guardian of 30 such child stating objections to such examination on religious 31 grounds.
