School districts; school boards.--12 (a) Each county shall constitute a school district; 13 provided, two or more contiguous counties, upon vote of the 14 electors of each county pursuant to law, may be combined into 15 one school district; and provided further that a county with 16 17 45,000 or more students in the district schools within the county may be divided into more than one school district, each 18 19 school district to have no less than 15,000 students, as 20 provided by general or special law, and subject to approval by a vote of the electors of the county. In order to divide a 21 22 county under this provision, and notwithstanding other provisions of this constitution, a commission may be created 23 by special law to draw school district boundary lines, 24 25 allocate assets, and make provisions for the contractual 26 obligations, debts, and bonded indebtedness of the school 27 district, all of which shall be subject to review and approval by the circuit court for compliance with state and federal 28 29 law. 1 divided pursuant to this section shall be calculated on a countywide basis and allocated as provided by general law. 2 3 (b) In each school district there shall be a school 4 board composed of five or more members chosen by vote of the 5 electors for appropriately staggered terms of four years, as б provided by law. 7 (b) The school board shall operate, control and 8 supervise all free public schools within the school district and determine the rate of school district taxes within the 9 10 limits prescribed herein. Two or more school districts may 11 operate and finance joint educational programs. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with the 12 requirements of section 101.161, Florida Statutes, the title 13 and substance of the amendment proposed herein shall appear on 14 the ballot as follows: 15 16 17 AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF A COUNTY INTO TWO OR MORE 18 19 SCHOOL DISTRICTS 20 Provides that counties with 45,000 or more students may 21 be divided into two or more school districts pursuant to 22 general or special law, and subject to local voter approval. 23 24 Provides a commission to draw district boundary lines, allocate assets, obligations, debts, and bonded indebtedness. 25 Provides that, except for millage voted for bonded 26 27 indebtedness, school district funding shall be calculated 28 countywide and allocated as provided by general law. 29 30 31
