any collegiate license plate created or established after
January 1, 1997, must comply with the requirements of s.
320.08053 and be specifically authorized by an act of the
Legislature. Collegiate license plates must bear the colors
and design approved by the department as appropriate for each
state and independent university. The word "Florida" must be
stamped across the bottom of the plate in small letters.
    2. Effective January 1, 1999, the department shall
develop a generic collegiate license plate as provided in this
section for independent universities and community colleges

in the state which collects 1,000 or more signatures of
persons agreeing to purchase such a specialty license plate.
