20	(2) The Legislature recognizes the importance of
21	interscholastic extracurricular student activities as a
22	complement to the academic curriculum. Participation in a
23	comprehensive extracurricular and academic program contributes
24	to student development of the social and intellectual skills
25	necessary to become a well-rounded adult. It is the intent of
26	the Legislature to provide the mechanism for all students in
27	Florida to participate in interscholastic extracurricular
28	activities. As used in this section, the term
29	"extracurricular" means any school-authorized or
30	education-related activity occurring during or outside the
31	regular instructional school day.

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(3)(a) To be eligible to participate in 1 2 interscholastic extracurricular student activities, a student 3 must maintain a grade point average of 1.5 on a 4.0 scale, or 4 its equivalent, and must pass five subjects for the grading 5 period immediately preceding participation; except that 6 student eligibility for the first grading period of each new 7 school year shall be based on passing five subjects and maintaining the required grade point average the previous 8 9 school year, including subjects completed during the interim summer school session. 10 (b) Any student who is exempt from attending a full 11 12 school day under s. 228.041(13) must maintain a 1.5 grade 13 point average and pass each class for which he or she is 14 enrolled. (c) An individual home education student shall be 15 16 eligible to participate at a public school, and may develop an 17 agreement to participate at a nonpublic school, in the 18 interscholastic extracurricular activities of that school, 19 provided the following conditions are met: 20 1. The home education student must meet the requirements of the home education program pursuant to s. 21 22 232.02(4). 23 2. During the period of participation at a school, the home education student must demonstrate educational progress 24 as required in paragraph (b) in all subjects taken in the home 25 26 education program by a method of evaluation agreed upon by the 27 parent and the principal which may include: review of the student's work by a certified teacher chosen by the parent; 28 29 grades earned through correspondence; grades earned in courses taken at a community college, university, or trade school; 30 31

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standardized test scores above the 35th percentile; or any 1 2 other method designated in s. 232.02(4). 3 The home education student must meet the same 3. 4 residency requirements as other students in the school at 5 which he or she participates. 6 4. The home education student must meet the same 7 standards of acceptance, behavior, and performance as required of other students in extracurricular activities. 8 The student must register with the school his or 9 5. her intent to participate in interscholastic extracurricular 10 activities as a representative of the school prior to the 11 12 beginning date of the season for the activity in which he or 13 she wishes to participate. A home education student must be 14 able to participate in curricular activities if that is a requirement for an extracurricular activity. 15 6. A student who transfers from a home education 16 17 program to a public school prior to or during the first grading period of the school year shall be academically 18 19 eligible to participate in interscholastic extracurricular activities during the first grading period provided the 20 21 student has a successful evaluation from the previous school 22 year, pursuant to subparagraph 2. 23 7. Any public school or nonpublic school student who has been unable to maintain academic eligibility for 24 participation in interscholastic extracurricular activities 25 26 shall be ineligible to participate in such activities as a home education student until such time as the student has 27 28 successfully completed one grading period in home education 29 pursuant to subparagraph 2. to become eligible to participate 30 as a home education student. 31
