Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 562.11, Florida Statutes, to read:

562.11 Selling, giving, or serving alcoholic beverages to person under age 21; misrepresenting or misstating age or age of another to induce licensee to serve alcoholic beverages to person under 21; penalties.--

(4) Any law enforcement officer, as defined in s.

943.10(1), may use persons under the age of 21 to assist the officer in enforcement efforts by testing vendor compliance with the prohibitions established in this section.

Notwithstanding the prohibitions contained in s. 562.111, such person acting on behalf of the law enforcement officer to test vendor compliance with the prohibitions established in this section shall be immune from civil and criminal liability

LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Provides that a law enforcement officer may use persons under the age of 21 with respect to alcoholic beverages and under the age of 18 with respect to tobacco products to assist the law enforcement officer in enforcement efforts by testing vendor compliance concerning the selling, delivering, bartering, furnishing, or giving of alcohol or tobacco products to minors.
