(2) Legal residents of the United States residing in 28 29 the state who are 65 years of age or older on the effective

date of this act, and who have lost benefits and applied for

are unable to obtain citizenship through no fault of their own, are eligible to receive benefits under state law which are equivalent to the Medicaid and other public assistance benefits provided to United States citizens residing in the state who are 65 years of age or older. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Prohibits discrimination between United States citizens and legal residents in the provision of Medicaid and other public assistance benefits in Florida. Provides certain assistance for legal residents who are applying for citizenship and for certain elderly persons who are unable to obtain citizenship.
