This prohibition does not 1 2 apply if the violator had prior actual knowledge of the 3 requirements of the regulation or if the agency determines the 4 violation constitutes an imminent detriment to the public health, safety, and welfare. 5 (2) In any criminal, civil, or administrative 6 7 proceeding to impose a penalty for a violation of, or to compel compliance with, the regulation, it is a defense that 8 9 the state agency has a pattern of failure to enforce the 10 regulation with respect to substantially the same violation 11 committed by others. 12 Section 2. A state agency that collects taxes or 13 regulates the activities of any profession, occupation, or 14 business and that has actual knowledge that a person has 15 violated one of the regulations applicable to the payment of those taxes or applicable to the profession, occupation, or 16 17 business or, with the exercise of due diligence, should have 18 known of the violation, is estopped from enforcing the regulation against the person if the state agency had actual 19 or imputed knowledge of the violation for a period of more 20 than 1 year and did not give the violator notice of the 21 22 requirements of the regulation within that time. 23 Section 3.
