Section 395.0164, Florida Statutes, is 15 16 created to read: 17 395.0164 Mobile surgical facilities.--(1) A mobile surgical facility is a semitrailer as 18 19 defined in s. 316.003 in which licensed medical professionals provide surgical procedures. It is not an ambulatory surgical 20 21 center. 22 (2) A mobile surgical facility that has a contract with the Department of Corrections to provide medical services 23 is exempt from the licensing and construction requirements of 24 25 chapter 395. A mobile surgical facility that is exempted from regulation under this section may serve only inmates who are 26 27 subject to oversight by the Department of Corrections. 28 (3) A mobile surgical facility may be used to provide 29 medical care to the public during a state or national 30 emergency, as the term "emergency" is defined in s. 252.34.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

SENATE SUMMARY Prescribes the characteristics of mobile surgical facilities. Provides that such facilities that contract with the Department of Corrections are exempt from certain licensing and construction requirements and may serve only inmates. Allows such facilities to provide medical care to the public during state or national emergencies.
