An act relating to dissolution of marriage;
creating s. 61.077, F.S.; providing a
presumption of fraud as to certain transfers;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 61.077, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

61.077 Fraudulent transfers.--After a petition for
dissolution is filed, any transfer of marital property by a
party to a nonparty without the knowledge and written consent
of the other party is presumed fraudulent.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
