1 notice to that effect is given to the convening authority by 2 such member. 3 (2) The time period for determining the right to a 4 speedy trial shall be tolled during the period of the 5 continuance, but the providing of such a continuance does б shall not waive act as a waiver to the right to a speedy 7 trial. The immunity herein granted in this section shall, upon the filing of a notice by the witness, extend to any member 8 9 not an attorney who is engaged in any proceeding before any 10 court or any state, county, or municipal agency or board in a representative capacity for any individual or group or as a 11 12 witness in any proceeding. (3) After the said notice has been filed by a member 13 14 of the Legislature called as a witness, the proceeding may 15 proceed notwithstanding such notice if the party calling such 16 member as a witness agrees shall agree. 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 18 law. 19 20 SENATE SUMMARY 21 Provides for a proceeding before a court or governmental agency to be continued if a legislator is scheduled to appear at the proceeding and the scheduled appearance conflicts with committee activity of the Legislature.
