Paragraph (b) of subsection (15) of section 121.021, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 11 12 121.021 Definitions.--The following words and phrases as used in this chapter have the respective meanings set forth 13 unless a different meaning is plainly required by the context: 14 (15)(a) Until October 1, 1978, "special risk member" 15 means any officer or employee whose application is approved by 16 17 the administrator and who receives salary payments for work performed as a peace officer; law enforcement officer; police 18 19 officer; highway patrol officer; custodial employee at a 20 correctional or detention facility; correctional agency 21 employee whose duties and responsibilities involve direct 22 contact with inmates, but excluding secretarial and clerical employees; firefighter; or an employee in any other job in the 23 field of law enforcement or fire protection if the duties of 24 25 such person are certified as hazardous by his or her employer. (b)1. Effective October 1, 1978, "special risk member" 26 27 means a member of the Florida Retirement System who is 28 designated as a special risk member by the division in accordance with s. 121.0515. Such member must be employed as 29

a law enforcement officer, a firefighter, or a correctional

officer and must meet certain other special criteria as set forth in s. 121.0515. 2. Effective January 1, 1999, the term "special risk member" also includes any member who is employed as a public defender investigator who meets the certification requirements of s. 943.13. Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1 of the year following the year in which it is enacted. HOUSE SUMMARY Redefines the term "special risk member" for the purposes of the Florida Retirement System to include members of the system who are public defender investigators who meet certification requirements as set forth in s. 943.13, F.S.
