Section 3. Subsection (2) of section 316.0895, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.0895 Following too closely.--

(2) It is unlawful for the driver of any motor truck, motor truck drawing another vehicle, or vehicle towing another vehicle or trailer, when traveling upon a roadway outside of a business or residence district, to follow within 300 feet of another vehicle, motor truck, motor truck drawing another vehicle, or vehicle towing another vehicle or trailer. The provisions of this subsection shall not be construed to prevent overtaking and passing nor shall the same apply upon any lane specially designated for use by motor trucks or other slow-moving vehicles.

Section 4. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall post the appropriate highway signs as required by this act within 180 days after the effective date of this act.

Section 5. This act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
