A. Basic Information

- 1. Claimant:** Tirini S. Riley (a minor)
- 2. Respondent:** South Broward Hospital District d.b.a. Memorial Hospital

B. Procedural Summary: The South Broward Hospital District and the claimant agreed to a settlement of \$1,100,000. The Circuit Court of the 17th Judicial Circuit entered a consent judgment for that amount. To date, the district has paid its statutory obligation of \$100,000. HB 1769 would require the South Broward Hospital District to pay the outstanding balance on the consent judgment.

C. Facts of the Case: Four-year old Tirini Riley suffered from tracheostenosis, a narrowing of the trachea which restricted breathing. On July 27, 1993, she was admitted to Hollywood Memorial Hospital to undergo a laryngotracheoplasty, a procedure designed to alleviate this condition. During recovery, Tirini Riley suffered cardiopulmonary arrest, resulting from a blockage of the endotracheal tube. She has been left in a state of static encephalopathy (a condition which prevents her from responding to her environment), and requires around-the-clock care.
