A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to district school board  
elections; requiring certain school districts  
to elect school district board members from  
single-member residence areas; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) In school districts having a  
population of 1 million or more persons, district school board  
members must be elected from single-member residence areas by  
electors residing in each of the single-member residence areas  
only, notwithstanding the provisions of sections 230.061,  
230.10, or 230.105, Florida Statutes.

(2) In school districts having a population of 1  
million or more persons, the district school board shall  
provide for the orderly transition to election from  
single-member residence areas as the terms of incumbent school  
board members expire.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires district school board members to be elected from  
single-member residence areas in school districts having  
a population of 1 million or more persons.
